How You Can Help

Tools Count! Our tools make a difference, and we need to ensure accurate inventory counts to keep those project orders filled. Our inventory is organized into 12 sections and volunteer teams are needed each month to count a section of tools.



Dare to Pair : The ToolBank loans more than 1,500 pairs of work gloves each month. As gloves are returned, they need to be sorted, matched in pairs, and placed in 25 count bags.



Sort & Stuff: The ToolBank also provides no-cost project supplies to complement tool orders. Volunteer groups sort donations and stock those shelves! Additionally, during high volume lending, tools will also need to be returned to the shelves.



Paint & Buff: All tools are sanded and painted our signature blue to help prevent splintering and ensure identification on a work site. When volunteers see blue, they know what to do – get that tool back to ToolBank so others can also make use of it.



Wind & Grind: For those who love tinkering with the toys, our in-house repair shop is just the ticket. Inspect, sharpen, re-attach, and everything in between to make sure the blue tools stay in rotation.
